Summary of Chicken Regulations (Cole Camp Code of Ordinance 560, Chapter 205:

- Maximum number of chickens on permitted property: six (6).
- Hens only - No roosters. (*Gallus gallus domesticus*)
- Chickens must be kept in an enclosure or fenced area at all times. Chickens shall be secured within a henhouse or chicken tractor during non-daylight hours.
- Enclosures must provide adequate ventilation and adequate sun and shade and must be impermeable to rodent, wild birds, and predators.
- Enclosures are allowed in the rear yard and must be at least 10 feet from the rear and side lot lines and 25 feet from adjacent dwellings.*
- Chickens shall be provided with access to feed and clean water at all times.
- The feed and water shall be unavailable to rodents, wild birds and predators.
- The stored manure shall be covered by a fully enclosed structure with a roof and lid over the entire structure.
- No chickens shall be allowed to run at large.
- Permit good for 1 year - March - February.
- Renewal of Permit: March 1st of each year.
- Fee for chicken permit is \$10.00. A \$1.00 delinquency fee per month if a permittee fails to renew.

This permit must be kept by the owner and presented upon demand by any city official. Permits are non-transferable and may not be sold or assigned. Annual renewal permits require full re-submittal. I grant the right for City staff to inspect my property at any time to ensure compliance and to investigate complaints.
